The cost of \$100,000.00 was divided among the resident and it came up to \$1,200.00 each. Another discussion mentioned that the residents did not feel they were forewarned.

Supervisor Manoleas stated that he was waiting for total cost in order to have all the information to relay to the residents. He also stated that he would take the blame on this, and that it could have been handled differently.

It was questioned that this was an emergency that took two years? More discussion.

Supervisor Manoleas announced to the residents present that this topic is on the next meeting's agenda for tonight.
