ABSENTEE VOTERS: If you wish to vote in person after obtaining an absentee ballot, you can do so at your early voting site or Election Day polling place. You can also put your absentee ballot through the tabulator at your early voting site or Election Day polling place or return it to the Clerk's Office to be tabulated on Election Day.

If you want to receive a ballot for all future elections, you can join the Permanent Absentee Ballot List. This eliminates the need to submit an absentee application each election. To enroll: Contact the Clerk's Office, or visit mi.gov/vote.

Frequently Asked Questions

Absentee Voting: How do I get an absentee ballot? Registered voters may request an absentee ballot by submitting an application online at mi.gov/vote, by mail, or in person at the Clerk's Office.

Early Voting: If I vote during the Early Voting period, can I change my vote on Election Day? No, once you cast your ballot during the 9-day early voting period, it is the same as casting your ballot on Election Day and it can not be changed.

Election Day Voting: Do I need to show ID in order to vote at the polls? Voters will be asked to present an acceptable photo ID. If a Voter is not in possession of their ID, they will be asked to sign an affidavit before being issued a ballot.

From the Office of the Treasurer:

IMPORTANT DATES:

Summer Property taxes Due September 14, 2026

Deferment Applications are Due September 14, 2026

Winter Property taxes are Due February 16, 2027 (without Penalty)

February 17 - March 1, 2027 Summer & Winter taxes with Penalty & Interest.

March 1, 2027 Final Day to pay Property Taxes for the 2026 tax roll.

Summer 2026 tax bills will be mailed out July 1, 2026 these are due September 14, 2026. Property Tax Deferment applications are due by September 14, 2026. (These are renewed ANNUALLY) Partial payments are accepted on all taxes. A 3% penalty is added to any unpaid balance on September 15, 2026 with another 1% being added the first of each month thereafter, until the books are closed on March 1st.

Payments may be made in person via cash, check or credit card, online via the township website, by mail, or by being placed in the after-hours box (by check only). Payments sent via mail are considered on time if **post-marked on or before the due date**. For all credit card transactions, there is a 3% fee added.

Tax bills are only mailed to property owners who do not have a mortgage/escrow account. For those with escrow accounts a Detailed Tax Certification will be mailed to you in January each year. If you cannot get your information online and would like a copy of your tax bill mailed or emailed to you, contact the Treasurer's Office at (810) 985-7258 ext. 201, or via email taxes@clydetownshipsc.org.

The Planning Commission meets the 2nd Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m.	Does your water bill seem high? Check immediately for leaks in your system. A dripping faucet, a leaking toilet or some other unsuspected leak may be the cause of a high-water bill. You can request a data log by calling the Water Department at (810) 985-7258. This will help identify high use issues that can be pinpointed to the day a leak or change of use occurred.

Keeping Chickens & Other Animals On Your Property (Zoning Ordinance Article 15, Section 15.18)

The township has received calls from residents about having chickens on their property and what regulations must be followed to own them.

The township's zoning ordinance allows farm animals if your property is located in the RA (Residential Agricultural) or RSF (Residential Suburban Farms) Districts and you have a land area of five (5) acres or more. Farm animals include cows, horses, alpaca, llamas, pigs, chickens, geese and ducks.

IF THE ABOVE SPACE(S) IS CERTIFIED AS ABANDONED A PERSON WHO POSSESSED THE RIGHT MAY BE ENTITLED TO REMEDIES AVAILABLE UNDER SECTION 17 OF THE MICHIGAN CEMETERY REGULATIONS ACT, 1968 PA 251, MCL 456.537, INCLUDING:

REINSTATEMENT OF THE RIGHT IF THE RIGHT HAS NOT BEEN RESOLD OR OTHERWISE TRANSFERRED TO ANOTHER PERSON.

IF THE RIGHT TO THE SPACE HAS BEEN RESOLD OR OTHERWISE TRANSFERRED TO ANOTHER PERSON, AT THE OPTION OF THE PERSON WHOSE RIGHT WAS CERTIFIED AS ABANDONED, EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:

A DIFFERENT RIGHT TO A SPACE OF COMPARABLE VALUE WITHIN THE CEMETERY.

COMPENSATION IN THE AMOUNT THAT THE PERSON WHOSE RIGHT WAS CERTIFIED AS ABANDONED PAID FOR THE RIGHT OR IN AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO 65% OF THE PRICE FOR WHICH THE RIGHT WAS RESOLD OR OTHERWISE TRANSFERRED BY THE CEMETERY OWNER OR OPERATOR, WHICHEVER AMOUNT IS GREATER.
